Characteristics of the unit:	Gizycko is located in the central part of the Masurian Lake District
	in the Land of the Great Masurian Lakes. The city lies on lakes
	Niegocin, Kisajno (the southern part of the Mamr complex), Tajty
	and Wojsak. Niegocin and Kisajno (through Tracz Bay) are
	connected by the Gizycki (Luczanski) Canal, and Niegocin is
	connected by the Niegocinski Canal with Lake Tajty and further by
	the Piękna Góra Canal with Kisajno. Part of the city is located on
	the so-called Gizycko Island, an isthmus surrounded on all sides
	by lakes and canals. The area around Gizycko has the largest
	number of lakes in Poland, their share in the total area of the land
	is 11.89% (23,986.6 hectares). That is why Giżycko is called the
	sailing capital of Poland. The Municipality of Giżycko is at the
	stage of preparing the Environmental Protection Program for
	2024-2027 with an outlook until 2031, and the most important
	goals and directions of activities in the field of socio-economic
	development and environmental protection include: protection
	of air, water, soil and land surface, rational use of natural
	resources, protection of natural resources, improvement and
	rationalization of the waste management system. The city of
	Giżycko covers an area of 14 square kilometers. The population is
	27,813 (as of 31/12/2022). Within the city of Gizycko, history
	lovers will visit the Boyen fortress, which was built in the 19th
	century as a bastion to block a strategic location, the isthmus
	between lakes Kisajno and Niegocin. Currently, there are four
	buildings in the fortress open to the public, which host
	permanent or temporary exhibitions.
