Administrative and geographical location (Położenie administracyjne i geograficzne)	The area of Ukmergė district is 1,395 km ² (29% of the territory is occupied by forests, 55% by agricultural land). The territory of Ukmergė city is 20.45 km ² Population: According to the Lithuanian Statistics Department, at the beginning of 2022, 34,028 people lived in the Ukmergė district. Distance to airports: Vilnius - about 80 km. Kaunas - about 55 km. Palanga - about 290 km. The distance to the railway is about 20 km. The distance to Klaipėda seaport is about 270 km.

	<p>The river Šventoji flows through Ukmergė - the largest river that flows entirely in the territory of Lithuania. Ukmergė is about 70 km away. far from the big cities of Lithuania - Vilnius, Kaunas, Panevėžys, Utena. Just 4 km. from Ukmergė stretches one of the largest highways in Lithuania, A2 Vilnius–Panevėžys–Riga, which connects Tallinn with Minsk. Ukmergė is also crossed by the highway A6 Kaunas-Utena, which connects Warsaw with Saint Petersburg. The convenient geographical location of the city creates excellent conditions for the development of the economy, entertainment, tourism, and the arrival of new large companies in the district. Ukmergė is a favorable investment environment for creating and developing a business.</p>
natural values (Walory przyrodnicze)	<p>Ukmergė district is located in the central plains of Lithuania. In the west and north-west, the landscape of the district consists of plains, the Aukštaičiai highlands begin at the eastern edge. The highlands of the territory are separated from the lowlands by Šventoji and its tributaries: Siesartis, Žuvintė, Žirnaja, Riešė, Ukmergėlė, Mūšia. There are 33 lakes in the region, the largest of which are: Lėnas (219 ha), Žirnaj (192 ha).</p> <p>The area of Ukmergė district is 1,395 km². The district stretches 47 km from north to south, 36 km from west to east. Ukmergė district borders Anykščiai in the north, Panevėžys in the northwest, and Kėdainiai districts in the west. Jonava is located in the southwest, Širvintos in the southeast, and Molėtai in the east. Ukmergė district in terms of area and population belongs to the largest Vilnius county in Lithuania.</p> <p>In the municipality of Ukmergė district, agricultural land accounts for 55 percent. of the land fund (91 percent of the area of agricultural land is occupied by arable land, another 9 are meadows and natural pastures, and only 0.4 percent of the area is for gardens). In the non-agricultural territory of the Ukmergė district municipality, 33 percent. occupied by forests, 3 percent of the land is built up, 2 percent. of land is occupied by water bodies, 1 percent. roads and 5 percent other land, e.g. wetlands or unused land.</p>
